

## Important Vaccine Information

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) is still requiring immunizations for the upcoming 2020-2021 school year.

**6th grade students:** The ISDH requires incoming 6th grade students to have a Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis), a Meningitis vaccine and the Hepatitis A vaccine series. Hepatitis A is a series of 2 vaccines administered at least 6 months apart.

**12th grade students:** The ISDH requires incoming 12th grade students to have a second MCV4 (Meningococcal) vaccine and the Hepatitis A vaccine series. Hepatitis A is a series of 2 vaccines administered at least 6 months apart.

**All Students:** The ISDH requires all students to complete the Hepatitis A vaccine series. Hepatitis A is a series of 2 vaccines administered at least 6 months apart.

These updates can be made at your physician's office or the health department. For your convenience, the Wabash County Health Department will be holding drive-in and walk-up open vaccine clinics **for students in grades 5-12 to update school required vaccines** on the following dates:

These clinics will be conducted outside to observe social distancing practices. No appointment is necessary. To expedite the process, those with private insurance coverage are encouraged to contact the health department at 260-563-0661 EXT 1329 or 1250 to pre-register. Students who have Medicaid or are without insurance do not need to pre-register.
